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INSTRUCTIONS FOR COLONOSCOPY PREPARATION WITH MIRALAX AND DULCOLAX

ONE WEEK BEFORE PROCEDURE:

- Avoid nuts, seeds, whole grain breads, popcorn.
- Make sure to read all of your instructions, and refresh your memory about how your doctor recommended you take your medications such as blood thinners, diabetes medications etc.
- You will need to obtain a 238 gram bottle of miralax and 4 dulcolax (bisacodyl) 5 mg tablets. These can be purchased without a prescription at your local pharmacy.
- Purchase 2 bottles (32 oz) of gatorade, crystal light, lemonade, water or iced tea (any flavor except ones that are colored red or purple).

<u>Medications – Unless otherwise discussed with your doctor:</u> Make sure to refresh your memory about how your doctor recommended you take your medications, especially if you are on blood thinners or anti-platelet drugs. Call us with ANY questions.

Stop aspirin, and anti-inflammatory drugs (ibuprofen, advil, aleve, diclofenac, celebrex, motrin), vitamin E, and fish oil 5-7 days prior to exam. Tylenol is OK to take.

- If you are taking coumadin, plavix, aggrenox, or other blood thinners, make sure your physician is aware and stop as directed. _____

- Please make sure to finish the entire prep and take as directed to ensure that it is effective and works properly.

DAY BEFORE PROCEDURE:

- It is okay to have a low fiber breakfast such as a piece of toast, hard boiled or scrambled eggs, low fat yogurt.
- NO solid food after 10 AM.
- Continue to drink plenty of clear liquids (nothing red or purple) up to **2 hours** prior to your procedure if being done at Metro Atlanta Endoscopy, (**4 HOURS** prior to your procedure if being done at Emory Saint Joseph's Hospital). Clear liquids include: water, fruit juices (apple, white grape, white cranberry, lemonade), clear broth or boullion, ginger ale or soft drinks, coffee, tea, jello, ice pops, gatorade, gummy bears, life savers, popsicles, orange/lime sherbert.
- Take 4 dulcolax tablets at 4:00 pm the night before your procedure
- For the first dose of the prep, between 4:00 and 6:00 pm, start the miralax prep. Mix 4 scoops of miralax in 1-32 oz gatorade or a clear liquid of your choice and drink. Drink this as tolerated over one hour.
- For the second dose of the prep:
- Nothing by mouth for the last <u>4 hours</u> prior to your colonoscopy if your procedure is being done at Emory Saint Joseph's Hospital, and <u>2 hours</u> prior to your colonoscopy if your procedure is being done at Metro Atanta Endoscopy.

Starting 4-6 hours before our procedure, mix 4 scoops of miralax in the other 32 oz gatorade or a clear liquid of your choice and drink. Drink this as tolerated over one hour.

- NOTE: individual responses to laxatives may vary. This may cause multiple bowel movements within 30 minutes or take several hours.
