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## INSTRUCTION FOR EGD PREPARATION

<u>Medications – Unless otherwise discussed with your doctor:</u> Make sure to refresh your memory about how your doctor recommended you take your medications, especially if you are on blood thinners or anti-platelet drugs. Call us with ANY questions.

- -Avoid NSAIDS (Aspirin, Motrin, Advil, Aleve, Ibuprofen, Naproxen, Celebrex, Diclofenac, etc), Vitamin E, and fish oil 5-7 days prior to your procedure. It is OK to take Acetaminophen.
- STOP ASA, Plavix, or other anti-platelet therapy 5-7 days prior to your procedure.
- Stop Coumadin, and other blood thinners as directed

## NO SOLID FOOD AFTER MIDNIGHT

You may have clear liquids up to 4 hours *BEFORE* YOUR PROCEDURE if done at Emory Saint Josephs Hospital, and 2 hours before your procedure if done at Metro Atlanta Endoscopy.

\*\*\*YOU MUST HAVE a responsible adult driver whom you know, to drive you home after the procedure due to IV medication. We can only discharge you in the care of a person known to you. We will <u>NOT</u> discharge you to a Taxi, Uber, or other driving service.
